# Glasgow Bail Curfew Service



## Criminal Justice Services



## What is Bail Curfew?

The Sacro Bail Curfew Service is run by Glasgow Criminal Justice Social Work, Court Bail Office in conjunction with Sacro.

A restriction is placed on an individual by the courts demanding they are in their identified accommodation within times specified by the Sheriff. An example being 7pm until 7am, until the individual presents at court.

### > What does the Bail Curfew Service aim to achieve?

- To provide a service that contributes to community safety
- To reduce the likelihood of individuals being held on remand by allowing them to remain in the community
- To offer the option of Bail Curfew to bail officers as an alternative to remand, additional to Bail Supervision
- To carry out spot checks within the remit of the Bail Order
- To report any concerns or breaches of the Bail Curfew to the bail officer
- To report any breaches of Bail Curfew to the designated police station
- To provide Bail Curfew records with details of times, dates and signatures of spot checks
- To provide written reports or attend court when required in relation to breaches of Bail Curfew
- To enhance the supervision of the Bail Service and contribute to the report compiled for the court
- To work in partnership and collaboration with bail officers and the courts.

### > How do I access Bail Curfew?

The court bail officer will carry out an assessment of suitability (can be requested).

### > What happens if I get Bail Curfew?

As soon as Bail Curfew is granted by the Sheriff at court and you are released:

- Your court bail officer will arrange an identification meeting with a member of staff from the Sacro Bail Curfew Team
- The staff member from Sacro will discuss and explain the curfew, how it works, who will visit, what to expect and any issues or concerns that you may have
- The initial curfew check will be carried out on the evening following this meeting with the Sacro staff member
- Bail Curfew checks will be carried out randomly, until you return to court.

### > What happens if I breach Bail Curfew?

- Sacro Bail Curfew staff will report any breach to the police immediately
- Sacro Bail Curfew staff will report any breach to your supervising officer/social worker
- The curfew may be stopped
- A report will be submitted to the court reflecting a breach of your conditions.
