These posts will be responsible for taking groups of up to 5 individuals and working with them as they work to complete hours of Community Payback, a sentence of the court.

The tasks will be varied, including; painting and decorating and also participation in various social enterprises. The post holders will require knowledge and skills in painting and decorating specifically, but this post requires flexibility. It is essential that you have excellent communication skills and an ability to work with a variety of individuals who will be from diverse backgrounds. It is also required that you are able to help the Community Payback Placements to develop or acquire skills.

You should have good basic decorating skills. A recognised qualification would be an advantage. You should be a good communicator, able to encourage and facilitate a good working environment. Experience of working with offenders would be beneficial. Knowledge of and a commitment to working within Health and Safety legislation is essential. Induction and training will be given.

You must have a full driving licence and, if possible, access to a car. You would be paid a mileage rate for use of the vehicle.

Hours of work available will vary and will include days, evenings and weekends.

You must be prepared to work within equal opportunities and anti- discriminatory standards.

Membership of the Protecting Vulnerable Groups Scheme (PVG) will be a requirement for this post.
