Mediation

Mediation offers an impartial, confidential service to help neighbours resolve disputes. Problems caused by children, noise, abusive behaviour and boundary disagreements are just some of the issues professional mediators can help to overcome.

Restorative Justice

Restorative justice facilitates a process involving both those harmed by and those responsible for offending behaviour. This service deals with both young people and adults.

Criminal Justice Services

Part of the work of the criminal justice service is to provide assistance to individuals involved in Criminal Justice Social Work, and assist in the management and monitoring of offenders. The service also provides assistance to individuals involved in the mental health system, where mental health issues have been a significant factor in offending behaviour. The service provides support to individuals to aid their re-integration into the community.
