What is Throughcare?

Throughcare is a support and information service available to all offenders, ex-offenders and their families. It can be accessed directly by self-referral, or through referral from any other agency.



> What can you expect from our Throughcare Service?

- Practical support to enable a successful return to community life following a prison sentence.
- Individual support to sustain positive attitudes and reduce the likelihood of re-offending.
- Families will be supported through any issues they may have, enabling them to continue supporting an individual throughout their time in custody.
- Throughcare will work in partnership with any other agency involved with the individual.
- Throughcare will accept self-referrals by telephone, in writing or by email. We also welcome referrals from other agencies.
- Throughcare can also be accessed through the Sacro 'Drop In'; Monday, Wednesday and Friday, between 1pm and 3pm.
- Throughcare recruits, trains and supports a team of community support volunteers who will work in all aspects of the service to ensure quality service provision.



> What are the aims of the Throughcare Service?

- To provide practical and emotional support to offenders, ex-offenders and their families.
- To support the reintegration into independent community life of anyone convicted of a crime.
- To support families through the issues raised by having a family member held in custody, or following their release back to the community.
- To offer a supportive Travel Service, providing travel information, transport and practical support to use the Assisted Prison Visiting Scheme.
