"GOOD NEIGHBOUR" COMPETITIONS – AUTUMN 2015**

RULES OF THE COMPETITIONS

1. Members of the public are invited to nominate a person whom they believe to be an exceptionally good neighbour. Any resident (aged 18 or over) of the City of Aberdeen or the council area of Aberdeenshire can be nominated for the competition.
2. The person nominating should complete the nomination form (available on the Sacro website) or post, fax or e-mail a letter stating in no more than 70 words why a person should win the good neighbour award. They should supply the name and address of the good neighbour and also their own name and contact details.

The closing date is **20 November 2015**.
4. There will be two winners – one for Aberdeen and one for Aberdeenshire, each with the prize of a meal for two. No cash equivalents are available.
5. Following shortlisting by Community Mediation staff, the winners will be chosen by members of the service advisory group. This group comprises representatives of the Police, Housing Agencies, Anti-Social Behaviour / Community Safety Teams and Sacro
6. The judges' decisions are final, and are not open for challenge or negotiation.
7. A person may not nominate a close blood or step relative (parent, son, daughter, brother, sister, grandparent, grandchild, aunt, uncle) or spouse / partner for this award.
8. The winners and the persons making the nomination agree to have their names mentioned in publicity, and to be photographed at the time of the award.
9. None of the judges, or employees of Sacro's Aberdeen or Aberdeenshire Community Mediation services, are eligible to participate in this competition.
